YOUR TICKETS

We're delighted to enclose your tickets to CarFest at Laverstoke Park Farm – **not long to go now!**

Please keep your email from See Tickets and the downloadable tickets and parking pass safe. Your order includes a FREE parking pass for your caravan tow vehicle, but **PLEASE MAKE SURE THAT YOU HAVE PURCHASED ANY ADDITIONAL CAR PARKING PASSES BEFORE YOU ARRIVE ON SITE. Passes will be more expensive to buy on site.**

You will need to print out your CCV Permit for your live-in vehicle and Car Park Passes for any additional vehicles and display these on your dashboard/windscreen when you arrive.

Your tickets can either be printed or scanned from your phone.

Please note the latest arrival time for access to the campsite is 8pm on Thursday and Friday.

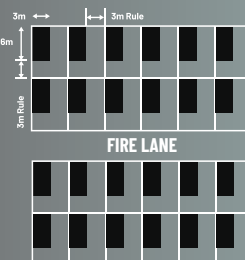
We would highly recommend that any visitors coming from the North and West DO NOT try and access the festival site from Whitchurch / Overton as the roads are very narrow and not suitable for Campervans or Caravans.

We would very much appreciate your support with this request, as we are doing our best to make your journey to the site as calm and stress free as possible, but also not to upset our local neighbours by congesting the village.

CCV PITCHES

We want to look after you as best we can but we also need to meet Fire Safety regulations and keep everyone safe therefore we need to ensure there is a 3 metre fire break between each and every caravan / live-in vehicle. There are no exceptions to this rule. To best manage our space, we have laid out all pitches in 6m x 9m blocks.

Caravans and live-in vehicles should neatly fit into front left or front right hand corner of your pitch depending if you are on the front or back row of a block. This orientation provides the 3 metre fire break between your home and your neighbours.



The diagram above shows the orientation and dimensions for reference. If you are putting an awning up please consider that they must be contained at least 50cm within your pitch as there needs to be a clear and uninterrupted gap between your pitch and the start of your neighbours.

SAFETY FIRST!

MOTORSPORT CAN BE DANGEROUS. Whilst the organisers take all reasonable precautions to ensure your safety, accidents can happen. You are attending CarFest at your own risk.

Please do consider that CarFest is an outdoor event held on a working farm with gradients/uneven surfaces. Whilst we have made a great effort to provide facilities to accommodate for this, there will inevitably be some areas that are hard to navigate.

ARRIVAL PROCESS

Upon arrival to the field you will be met by a CarFest Steward who will show you to your pitch. Once you are pitched please go to the wristband collection tent located in the field to exchange your tickets for wristbands. Stewards will be available to help with any queries you might have.

Hookup points for Caravans and Campervans will be provided on a standard Blue 16amp 240volt connection socket. It is hoped that the socket provision will be located within 20 metres of your pitch.

All tow-in vehicles will be directed to park in an adjacent field which will be easy to access. Information about bringing the vehicles back into the campsite when you are ready to leave will be given to you at the event.

The campsite closes at 11am on Monday 25th August.

PLEASE NOTE: IF YOU ARE ARRIVING AS PART OF A GROUP AND WISH TO PARK TOGETHER, THEN PLEASE ENSURE YOU ARRIVE TOGETHER. WE ARE UNABLE TO SAVE SPACES FOR GUESTS ARRIVING LATER.

TRAVELLING FROM THE NORTH

Take the A34 South to the A303 junction, eastbound towards London and then follow the CarFest event signage.

TRAVELLING FROM LONDON, GUILDFORD & THE SOUTH EAST

Take the M3 to junction 8, then follow the CarFest event signage.

TRAVELLING FROM THE SOUTH & SOUTH WEST

Take the M3 to junction 9, then take the A34 North to the A303, following signs to CarFest.



TRAVELLING TO CARFEST

CarFest takes place at Laverstoke Park Farm near the village of Overton. There is a high volume of traffic arriving for the event and in order for us to keep the traffic flowing smoothly **please follow the CarFest signs** as soon as you start to see them.

There are temporary one way systems in place for the weekend, which your SatNav will not recognise, so whilst useful for getting you into the right area, please ensure that you follow the CarFest signs.

Once close to the event please follow the signs for 'Motorhomes and Caravans'.

PLEASE READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. ONCE YOU START TO SEE SIGNS TO CARFEST PLEASE SWITCH OF YOUR SATNAV AND FOLLOW THE RELEVANT ROAD SIGNS AS DIRECTED.
