You will need to print out your parking pass and display this on your windscreen when you arrive.**

## BLUE BADGE PARKING



For Accessible parking follow the general CarFest traffic signage on the main approach to the event. As you get closer to the event site there will be specific signage for Blue Badge parking.

Parking spaces are allocated on a first come first served basis and cannot be pre-booked.

Blue Badge Permits will be required before entry into the car park. Parking spaces are restricted to one badge per car, any additional cars with friends and family members not holding a Blue Badge will need to park in the main festival car parks.

## SAFETY FIRST!

**MOTORSPORT CAN BE DANGEROUS.** Whilst the organisers take all reasonable precautions to ensure your safety, accidents can happen. You are attending CarFest at your own risk.

Please do consider that CarFest is an outdoor event held on a working farm with gradients/uneven surfaces. Whilst we have made a great effort to provide facilities to accommodate for this, there will inevitably be some areas that are hard to navigate.



## TRAVELLING FROM THE NORTH

Take the A34 South to the A303 junction, eastbound towards London and then follow the CarFest event signage.

## TRAVELLING FROM LONDON, GUILDFORD & THE SOUTH EAST

Please take the M3 and join the A303 heading West to Andover, and then follow the CarFest event signage.

## TRAVELLING FROM THE SOUTH & SOUTH WEST

Take the M3 to junction 9, then take the A34 North to the A303, and then follow the CarFest event signage.

## LOCAL TRAFFIC

Please approach from Overton Village and head south on the C29 and you will enter via Gate D1, which is approximately 1/4 mile from the village on your left.

## BY TRAIN & TAXI

The nearest stations to CarFest are Overton (3 miles) and Micheldever (3.2 miles), with larger stations at Basingstoke (11.5 miles) and Andover (15.5 miles).

If you are arriving by Taxi, please enter the site via C29. The entrance will be signposted as Gate A2. Vehicles must enter the drop off and pick up field and not use the road for drop off and pick up.
